HISTORY

The National Service Scheme was launched in 1969. It aims at the involvement mainly of undergraduate students on a voluntary basis in various activities of social service and national development which while making a contribution to socio-economic progress would also provide opportunities to the students to understand and appreciate the problems of the communities, awaken social consciousness and inculcate in them a sense of dignity of labour. The response to the various programmes organized was tremendous. At the same time, there has been a demand from several quarters that opportunity should be provided to the youth going out of the universities and colleges to engage themselves on a whole-time basis for a specific period in activities of social and national service. Some attempts in this direction have been made in some states during last few years.

identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem-solving
develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility
utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community

gain skills in mobilizing community participation
acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitudes
develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters and


Student led society whose purpose is to engage with sustainability


