





2. Sustainably farmed food on campus

Kalasalingam Academy of Research and Education (KARE) promotes sustainable production of food through cultivation of various agricultural and horticultural crops. The attainment of sustainable food production in KARE has been achieved with the availability of instructional farm land at university campus including crop cafeteria, Alagapuri farm and Gopinayakkanpatty farm with an area of 58 acres, 62 acres, and 220 Acres {(50 acres under cultivation) and (45 acres- second phase of land preparation)}, respectively. These farm lands are dedicated to students taking life exploration, hands-on training and development courses within the General

Education program. The harvested farm produce was sold to the university workers and local people through a sales counter at subsidized price in the university premises.
