13.3.2 – Climate Action Plan (Shared)

Kalasalingam Academy of Research and Education (KARE) has established a comprehensive Climate Action Plan that outlines the university's commitment to environmental sustainability and climate resilience. The plan focuses on key areas such as carbon footprint reduction, renewable energy adoption, efficient waste and water management, biodiversity protection, and climate education. It renewable energy adoption, aligns with India's national climate goals and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 13 – Climate Action.

The university's <u>Policy on Climate Action</u> clearly define strategic targets to move toward a carbon-neutral campus. These policies emphasize reducing greenhouse gas emissions, increasing tree cover, promoting clean energy, and integrating climate literacy into academic and community programs. The plan also encourages student and faculty participation through initiatives like Green Week, **Vehicle-Free Day**, and large-scale plantation drives.
