### 13.3.5 – Environmental Education: Collaboration with NGOs

Kalasalingam Academy of Research and Education (KARE) gives high importance to environmental education and works closely with several non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to promote sustainability and climate awareness. The institution's vision and mission strongly support social responsibility and environmental protection. KARE conducts awareness and training programs in association with NGOs to educate students and the local community on topics such as waste management, renewable energy, water conservation, and pollution control.

Through initiatives like **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan**, the university has adopted five nearby villages where faculty and students, in collaboration with NGOs, organize tree plantation drives, cleanliness campaigns, and workshops on sustainable farming practices. The **Atal Community Innovation Centre (ACIC-KIF)**, established with the support of **NITI Aayog**, also partners with community-based organizations and NGOs to promote eco-friendly innovations and rural entrepreneurship.

In addition, KARE's **National Service Scheme (NSS)** units regularly collaborate with environmental NGOs and the **Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board** to conduct community outreach activities and environmental rallies. These programs help create awareness about climate change, biodiversity conservation, and responsible resource use among students and the public.

The university also follows green campus initiatives such as solar power generation, sewage treatment, and waste recycling, which are supported by external environmental agencies. Through these collaborations, KARE integrates environmental education with social engagement, encouraging students to apply their knowledge to protect the planet and contribute to **Sustainable Development Goal 13 – Climate Action**.
